### **Rangeley Star Wall Quilt (32" x 42")**

The Rangeley Stars have a complex look, but are actually very easy to construct. Using the Tucker Trimmer tool and an additional trim, all those complicated star points become simple to make. Just what we like! You'll learn everything you need to know (and a little more!) about the Tucker Trimmer. And you'll understand why I call it my favorite "power tool"!

#### **Fabric for Rangeley Star Wall Quilt**

This quilt can be made with as few as 4 fabrics or it can be made scrappy by using multiple fabrics for any of the listed amounts.

Multicolored/Focus fabric	¾ Yard
Star point fabric(s)	¾ yard
Accent fabric	½ yard
Background fabric(s)	1 1/3 yards



We will be making the center four stars in class. The pieces must be cut before class. I like to use a separate zip-loc bag for each star. Label each bag. Complete the chart using your fabric colors – it will be much easier for you to cut your fabrics. The stars outside the center block are all small stars. Cut as many of those as you can before class.– you will need 14 additional stars. Bring extra fabric!

#### **You will need to bring:**

**Tucker Trimmer I tool - required**, available in class (\$20.00)

**Rangeley Wall Quilt pattern** – required – available in class (\$12.00)

Sewing machine in good working order

Thread and full bobbin

Rotary cutter and mat (a new blade)

Magic Wand - optional, but highly recommended, available in class (\$6.00)

Pigma marking pen or Fine Line Sharpie marker or mechanical pencil

General sewing tools - scissors, seam ripper, stiletto, pins etc....

#### **Other optional items that might come in handy:**

Extension cord

Light

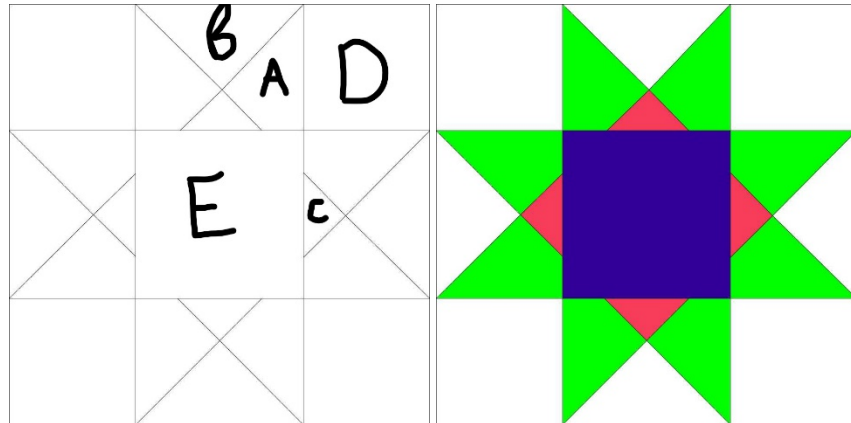

Medium Star Color (green)	Fabric	Number of squares	Size of squares	Part of block (the colors in mine are listed as a guide)
	A	2	5" x 5"	Star points - green
	B	1	5" x 5"	Background - white
	C	1	5" x 5"	Accent - red
	D	4	3" x 3"	Background - white
	E	1	4" x 4"	Focus fabric – center of star - print

Small Star Color (blue)	Fabric	Number of squares	Size of squares	Part of block
	A	2	3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Star points
	B	1	3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Background
	C	1	3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Accent
	D	4	2" x 2"	Background
	E	1	2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	Focus fabric – center of star

Small Star Color (yellow)	Fabric	Number of squares	Size of squares	Part of block
	A	2	3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Star points
	B	1	3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Background
	C	1	3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Accent
	D	4	2" x 2"	Background
	E	1	2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	Focus fabric – center of star

Small Star in large star Color (green)	Fabric	Number of squares	Size of squares	Part of block
	A	2	3 ½" x 3 ½"	Star points
	B	1	3 ½" x 3 ½"	Background (same fabric as accent in large star)*
	C	1	3 ½" x 3 ½"	Accent
	D	4	2" x 2"	Background
	E	1	2 ½" x 2 1/2 "	Focus fabric – center of star

Large Star Color (red)	Fabric	Number of squares	Size of squares	Part of block
	A	2	6 ½" x 6 ½"	Star points
	B	1	6 ½" x 6 ½"	Background
	C	1	6 ½" x 6 ½"	Accent*
	D	3	4" x 4"	Background
	E	1	Small Star	center of star

You will need 14 more small stars to complete your quilt. Cut the squares using the chart for Small Star Color Blue. Cut the squares for class if you would like to – some students get many of these done in class. If you are using lots of fabrics, it's fun to mix and match colors as you go!
